Note: The BR drum machine does not have a drum sound for MIDI note values 35 (Acoustic Bass Drum) and 40 (Electric Snare). However, if you import an SMF containing those MIDI note values, the BR will translate them into 36 (Bass Drum) and 38 (Acoustic Snare).

The BR drum machine contains sounds for Cross Stick (31), Metronome (click) (33), and Metronome (bell) (34). However, these note values are outside the normal range of General MIDI drum note values, so they aren't available in Anvil Studio.
